Are You Registered to Vote? Is Your Voting Information Current? Do You Know Your New District?

You must register or update your voter registration no later than 30 days before an election. Upcoming voter registration deadlines:

- **July 5, 2022**, for August 2, 2022 Special Election - Ohio House and Senate
- **October 11, 2022**, for the November 8, 2022, General Election

Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

How to Check Online to Make Sure Your Voting Information is Current and Find Your New District

Go to: <https://boe.cuyahogacounty.gov/voters/get-your-voting-information>

You will enter your last name and date of birth. Once submitted, you will be presented with your:

- Address
- **Current polling location including directions**
- Precinct
- Party Affiliation
- Election Dates for the next election
- **Districts:** (Congressional, House, and State Senate as well as County Council, Library, Court, and Board of Education)

To Vote in Ohio you must: be a citizen of the United States. • be at least 18 years old on or before the next general election. • be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before the election.

Early In-Person Absentee Voting

- For August 2nd - Early in-person absentee voting begins July 6th (the first day after the close of voter registration).
- For November 8th - Early in-person absentee voting begins on October 12th (the first day after the close of voter registration).
- Check with your county board of elections for locations OR check your voter information online.

Absentee Voting by Mail

To request an Absentee ballot application form. Go to: www.ohiosos.gov/elections/voters/absentee-ballot

Absentee voting begins the day after the close of voter registration (July 6th and October 12th). You must complete and submit a separate application for each election in which you want to vote.

- July 30th - Applications for absentee ballots to be mailed for the August 2 primary/special election must be received by noon (3 days before primary/special election).
- August 12th - Absentee ballots for the August 2 primary/special election returned by U.S. Mail **must be postmarked** no later than August 1 and received by boards of elections to be counted (10 days after primary/special election).
- November 5th - Applications for absentee ballots to be mailed for November 8 general election must be received by boards of elections by noon (three days before the general election).
- November 18th - Absentee ballots returned by U.S. Mail **must be postmarked** no later than November 7 and received by boards of elections by this date to be counted (10 days after the general election).
