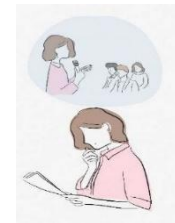

Here are the steps you need to follow to participate in the YC Competition:

1. Visit the website to download forms and complete the bio. Turn in bio forms to your local president or the person who asked you to speak.
2. Choose a topic, research, and construct your speech.
3. Speeches are to be 4 minutes in length. No props are allowed, and the YC competitor must remain at the podium.
4. Practice! Remember, experts recommend 1-2 hours of work for every minute of a speech. The more you practice, the more prepared and ready you'll feel.
5. Get ready for the local and regional speak-offs. Meet members, attend events, and have fun.
6. Submit all paperwork to Region chairs, who will submit all paperwork to the state chair.
