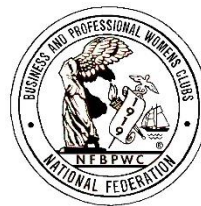

Steps to YC Competition

1. Visit the website to download forms, and complete the bio. Turn in bio forms to your local president or to the person who asked you to speak.
2. Choose a topic, do some research and construct your speech.
3. Practice! Experts recommend 1-2 hours of work for every minute of a speech.
4. Get ready for the local and regional speak offs. Meet members, attend events, and have fun.
5. Submit all paperwork to region chairs, and region chairs will submit all paperwork to state chair.
