UPDATE ON ERA LEGISLATION - BPW/OHIO donated \$500 to United4Equality, here is an update. There are two tracts being implemented to pass the ERA. One starts the whole ratification process all over and one eliminates the deadline for ratification allowing three more states to ratify and therefor become an amendment to the Constitution. In both the House

and Senate, these measures are stuck in committee and given the composition of the new Congress, unlikely to move unless pressure is brought to bear on the legislators. NEW LEGISLATION INTRODUCED IN US HOUSE - Republicans in the newly sworn-in House <u>introduced</u> the "Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act" on the first day of Congress, and a vote on the measure was scheduled for January 22, when tens of thousands of activists will be in Washington for the annual March for Life rally. The measure will easily pass the GOP-controlled House, but its fate in the Senate is less certain.
